

GREEK¹ AND HEBREW² TEXTS OF JOEL 2.28-32

- 28 And it shall be after these things,
I will pour out of my spirit on all flesh,
and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy,
and your old men shall dream dreams,
and your young men shall see visions.
- 29 Even on the male and female slaves,
in those days, I will pour out of my spirit.
- 30 I will give portents in the sky and on earth: blood and fire and the vapor of smoke.
- 31 The sun shall be turned to darkness, and the moon to blood, before the great and notable day of the Lord comes.
- 32 And it shall be, everyone who calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved, because in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be one who escapes, as the Lord has said, and people who have good news announced to them, whom the Lord has called.
- 28 And it shall come to pass afterward,
that I will pour out my Spirit on all flesh;
your sons and your daughters shall prophesy,
your old men shall dream dreams,
and your young men shall see visions.
- 29 Even on the male and female servants
in those days I will pour out my Spirit.
- 30 And I will show wonders in the heavens and on the earth, blood and fire and columns of smoke.
- 31 The sun shall be turned to darkness, and the moon to blood, before the great and awesome day of the Lord comes.
- 32 And it shall come to pass that everyone who calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved. For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be those who escape, as the Lord has said, and among the survivors shall be those whom the Lord calls.
